

949MB NEAR 67S 106W CONTINUES TO FILL AND WILL OPEN AND BE ABSORBED INTO THE LARGER LOW TO THE NORTH BY 06/1500Z. SKIES SHOULD CLOUD UP AS WEAKENING LOW DIPS SOUTH WITH A CHANCE OF LIGHT PRECIPITATION FROM APPROXIMATELY 05/1500 THROUGH 05/1800Z. LATE IN THE FORECAST PERIOD A REALTIVELY WEAK TROUGH MOVES INTO THE AREA FROM THE EAST PUSHING ANOTHER AREA OF LIGHT PRECIPITATION THROUGH. PRESSURE GRADIENT LOOSENS SLIGHTLY AS THE LOW FILLS, BUT WIND SPEEDS SHOULD REMAIN IN THE 15-20 KNOT RANGE FROM THE SOUTHEAST.
