

959MB LOW NEAR 68S 105W BECOMES ABSORBED EARLY IN PERIOD BY THE LARGER AND DEEPER 944MB LOW FURTHER TO THE NORTH. SKIES REMAIN CLOUDY AS
THE PARENT LOW TO THE NORTH SLOWLY REORIENTS AND DROPS SOUTHEASTWARD AND THEN SOUTH-SOUTHWESTWARD TOWARDS YOUR OPAREA. BY 07/06Z, A
DECENT-SIZED BAND OF SNOW WILL HAVE WORKED IN OVER YOUR AREA, REDUCING VISIBILITY AS IT MOVES WESTWARD OUT AHEAD OF THE LOW. WINDS WILL
REMAIN A BIT BREEZY OVER THE AREA AS THE GRADIENT REMAINS TIGHTENED THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD.
