



METSIT 06Z 9-Nov Moderate, fairly zonal west-to-east flow will be the rule across the Drake Passage during much of your voyage. Expect building seas once you leave the protection of land tomorrow afternoon and evening. However, by Drake Passage standards, winds and seas will be far below extreme values. With no major low pressure systems expected, mostly fair weather is likely from tomorrow afternoon into the early afternoon of the 10th. There should be enough wind to prevent large areas of dense fog.

FORECASTER NOTES Due to a problem with the FNMOC server, we were unable to access our normal weather charts to display for this WEAX.
