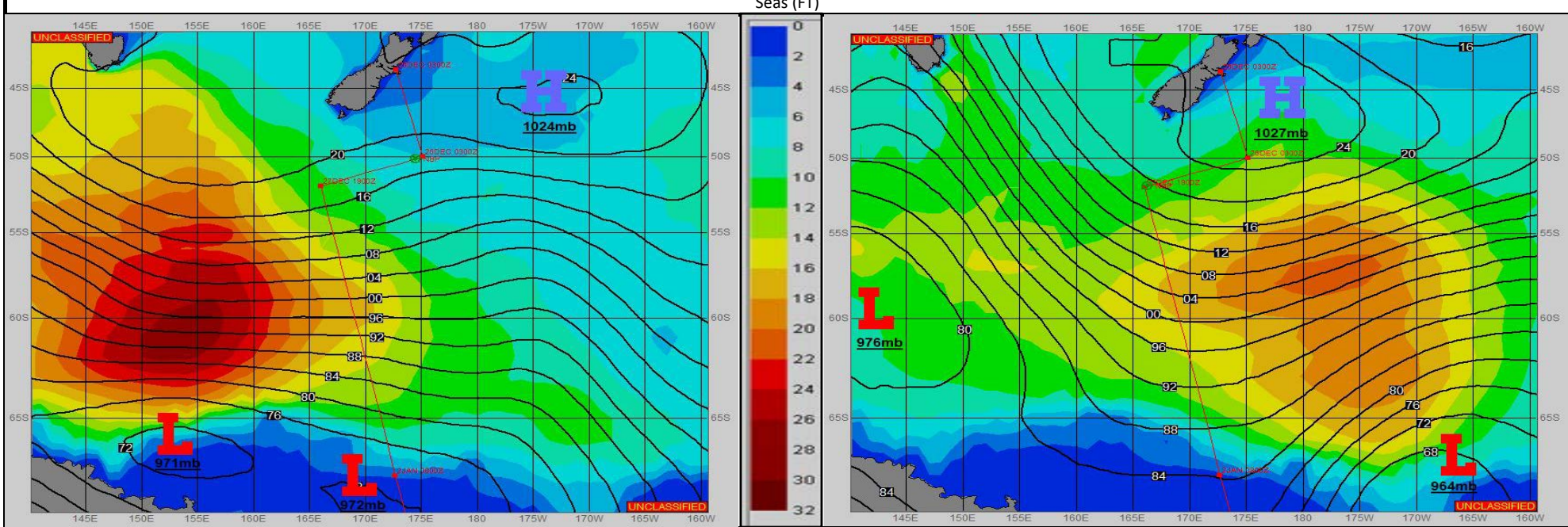

METSIT 06Z 26-Dec A LARGE LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM IS PASSING BY CAPE ADARE, BRINGING A LONG FETCH OF WINDS ACROSS THE SOUTHERN OCEAN. WHILE THE STRONGEST WINDS WILL REMAIN WELL SOUTH OF YOUR POSITION, THE WAVE HEIGHTS WILL INCREASE LATER TONIGHT INTO TOMORROW. THE FOG AND CLOUDS WILL MOSTLY DISSIPATE OVERNIGHT TONIGHT AS A BRIEF RIDGE PASSES OVERHEAD, BUT THE NEXT LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM BEGINS TO MOVE INTO THE AREA BY THE END OF THE PERIOD.
