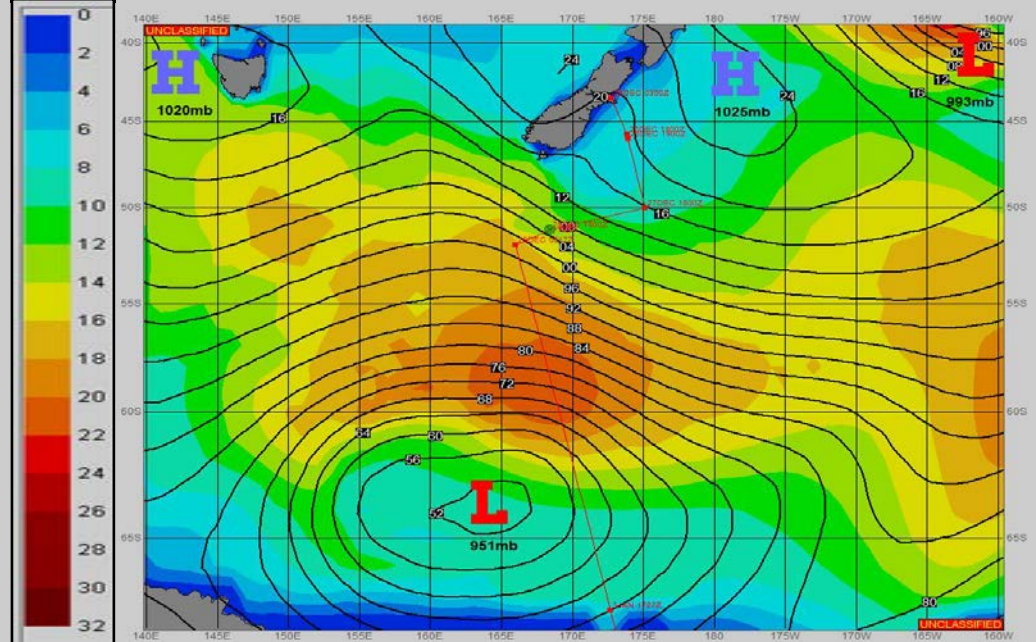
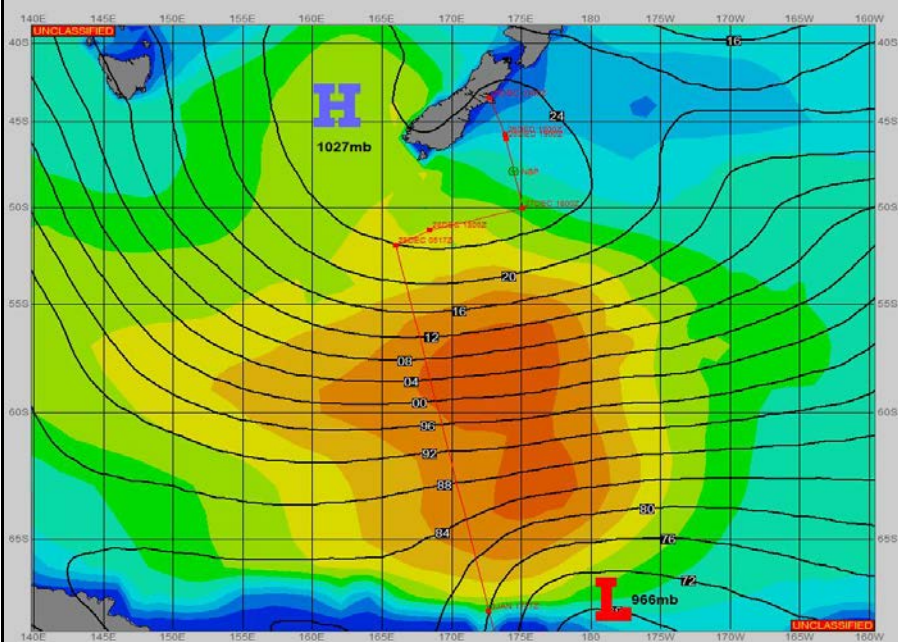

METSIT 06Z 27-Dec A LARGE AND STRNGTHENING LOW PRESSURE CENTER IS PASSING ALONG THE ANTARCTIC COAST, TO THE SOUTHWEST OF YOUR LOCATION AND MOVING EAST. WITH THE PRESSURE GRADIENT TIGHTENING, WINDS WILL CONTINUE TO INCREASE THROUGH TOMORROW, WITH WAVE HEIGHTS PREDOMINATELY IN THE 10-15FT RANGE. SKIES WILL REMAIN CLOUDY, WITH FOG TRANSITIONING INTO RAIN AS YOU APPROACH THE TOPSIDE OF THE LOW. THE CIRCULATION WILL CONTINUE MOVING EASTWARD, BUT WILL LARGELY BLOCK YOUR PATH THROUGH THE FORECAST PERIOD.
