

THE LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM CONTINUES TO MOVE OFF TO THE EAST, BUT DUE TO THE STRONG RIDGE BUILDING IN FROM THE NORTH, THE PRESSURE GRADIENT BETWEEN THE SYSTEMS WILL SUSTAIN HIGHER WINDS THROUGH THE PERIOD. WAVE HEIGHTS WILL BACK OFF SLIGHTY. CLOUDY SKIES WILL BE IN AND OUT, BUT FOG AND RAIN WILL BE FAIRLY CONSTANT AND WILL CONTINUE TO REDUCE VISIBILITY. TEMPERATURES WILL ALSO BEGIN TO COOL QUITE NOTICEABLY AS YOU PROGRESS FURTHER SOUTH.
