

The low pressure system pushing past Cape Adare continues to strengthen, ramping up wind speeds fairly quickly as you press southward. Despite the strong headwind, the wave heights are expected ro remain relatively low as the ice coverage continues to thicken. Winds will back off tomorrow, with the low pressure system continuing eastward and away from your course. Foggy conditions will once again prevail, though the skies will begin to open up tomorrow as you enter the Ross Sea.
