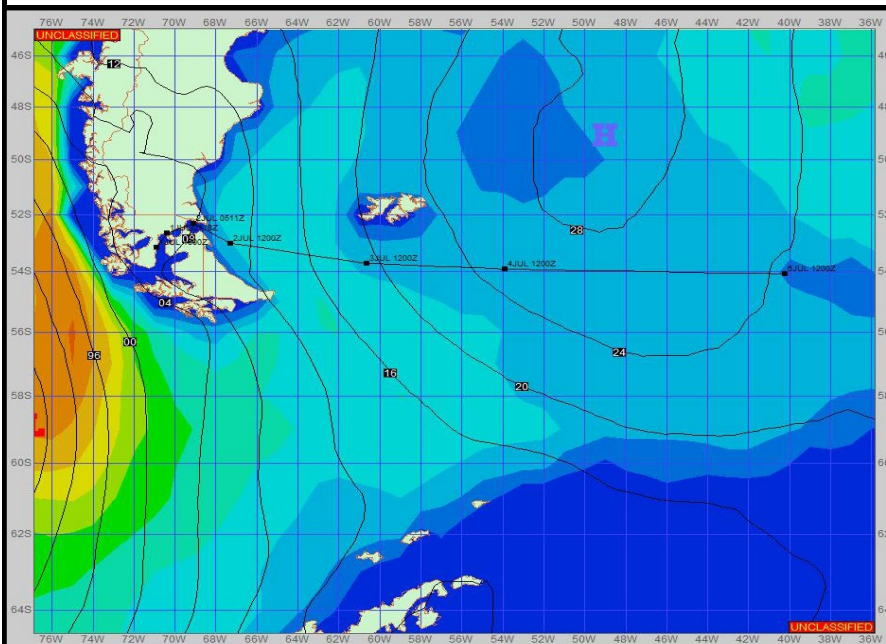
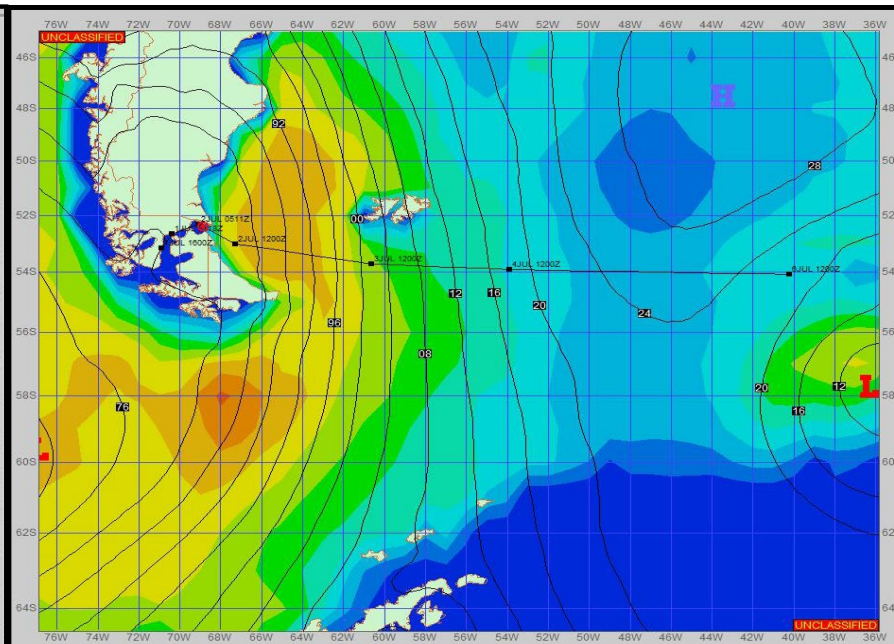

Mixed precipitation with light winds while sitting in port prior to heading out. High pressure sits northeast of South George Island. A deep low pressure is moving west to east, west of South America. As the low approaches, expect winds to increase and precipitation to once again start. Sea states increase significantly near the end of the forecast as water is squeezed through the Drake Passage. Good news at this point, is the "bubble" stays out ahead of your path.
