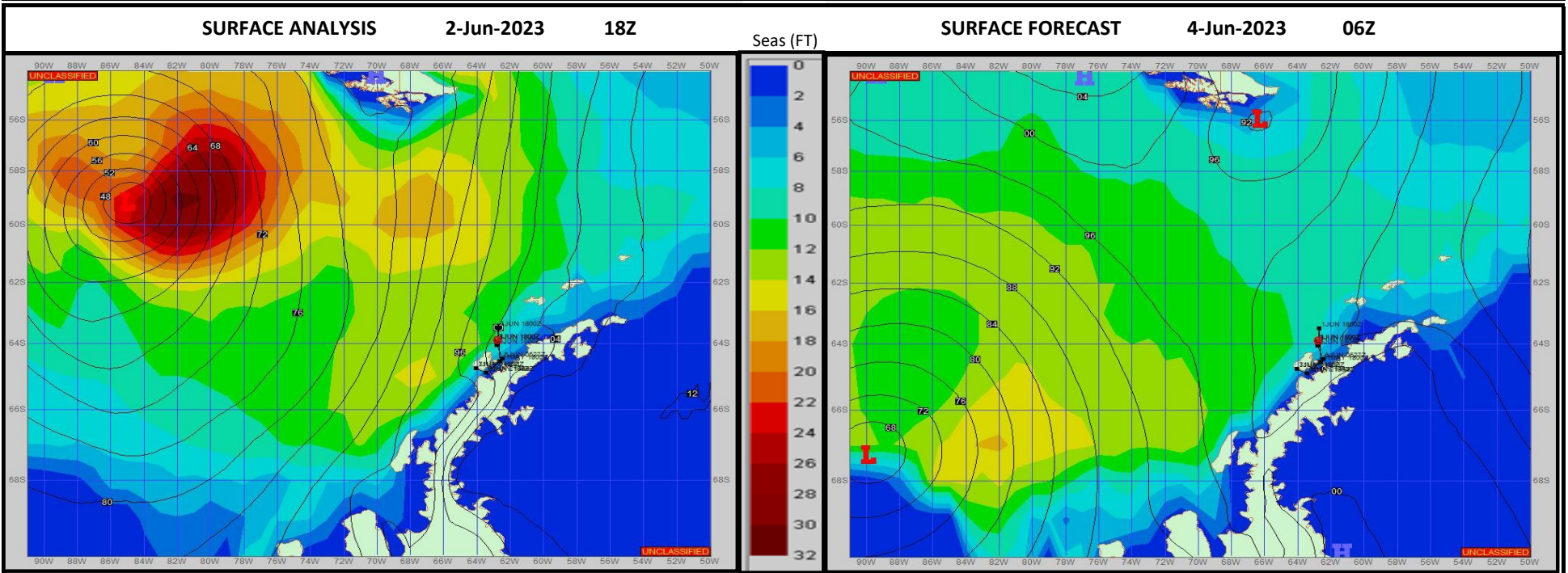

**METSIT 21Z 2-Jun** That deep low pressure out west continues to move south. Strong gusty winds are expected to blow to the southwest throughout. Higher sea states out west, in the open waters and into the Dallman Bay area should be expected with the pressure gradient. Temperatures again, remain around the freezing mark, which could result in either snow, rain and/or mixed precipitation when/if it occurs. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
