

Not much in the way of significant weather features. The high pressure in the Weddell Sea just meanders about throughout the forecast period. Cloudy skies, with intermittent rain ending early. Being sheltered between islands will help keep winds light and variable with insignificant seas. Winds may differ due to funneling/sheltering effects of the islands.
