

EXPECT POTENTIAL REDUCED VISIBILITY IN FOG AND ISOLATED LIGHT SNOW FROM APPROXIMATELY 04/0600Z THROUGH 04/1800Z AS HIGH PRESSURE BUILDS IN FROM THE NORTHWEST PRESSING LOW LEVEL MOISTURE INTO THE AREA AND INCREASING SOUTHWEST WIND SPEEDS.
