

A quasi-stationary low is present in the Bellingshausen at 938MB is expected to support a short wave trough progressing towards the Antarctic Penisula over the next 48 hours. Once in the Gerlache Strait, expect gusty winds upwards of 25kts and light snow reducing visibility to 2-4 miles, with periods of visibility restricted to 1 miles due the addition of sea fog.
