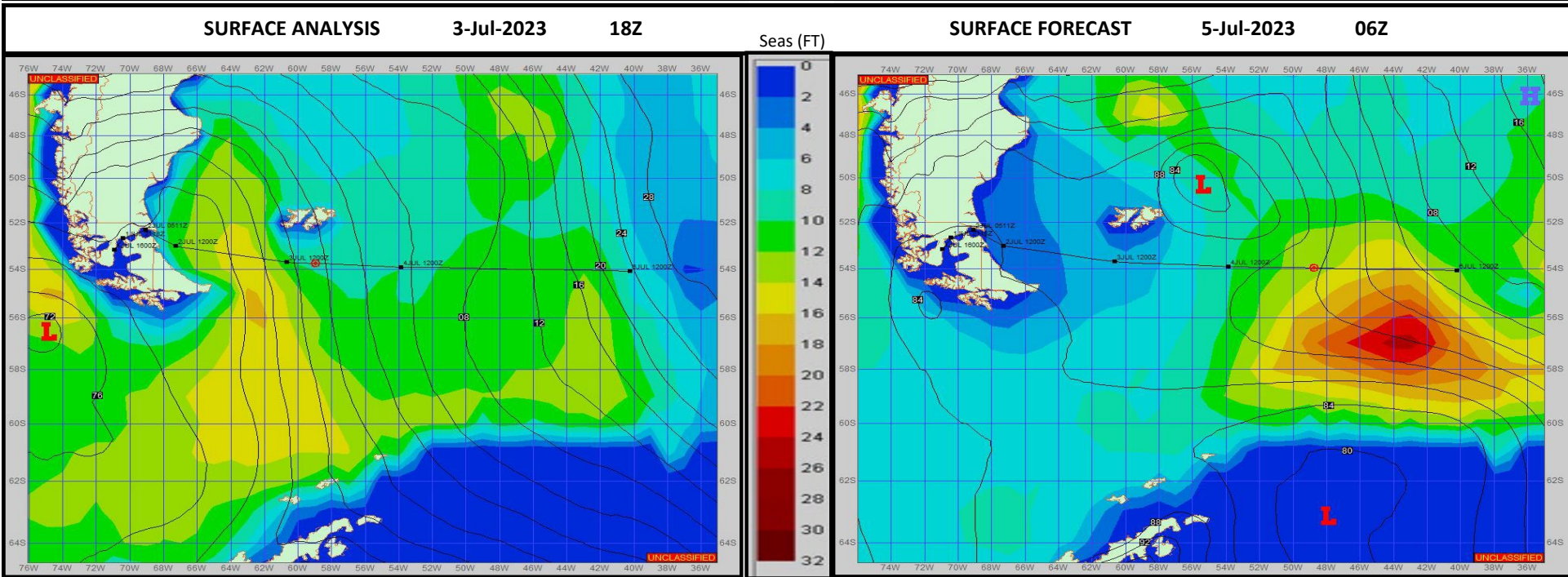

**METSIT 21Z 3-Jul** A low pressure system pushes through the Drake once again, and continues it's westward track. This produces a swell "bubble" east of the Falkland Islands, directly in your path of travel. Mean while, a low pressure systems develops off the coast of SA and moves east southeast. This will increase the pressure gradient later in the period. Separate systems, but the winds will remain high as will sea states.
