

HIGH PRESSURE IN THE SOUTH PACIFIC DRIFTING EAST ACROSS SOUTHERN SOUTH AMERICA WILL BUILD A RIDGE AXIS INTO CENTRAL DRAKE'S PASSAGE DURING THE FORECAST PERIOD PRODUCING A RELATIVELY STEADY WEST-SOUTHWEST PRESSURE GRADIENT. EXPECT PERIODS OF REDUCED VISIBILITY IN AREAS OF FOG BEING MOVED EAST AHEAD OF THE RIDGE AXIS.
