

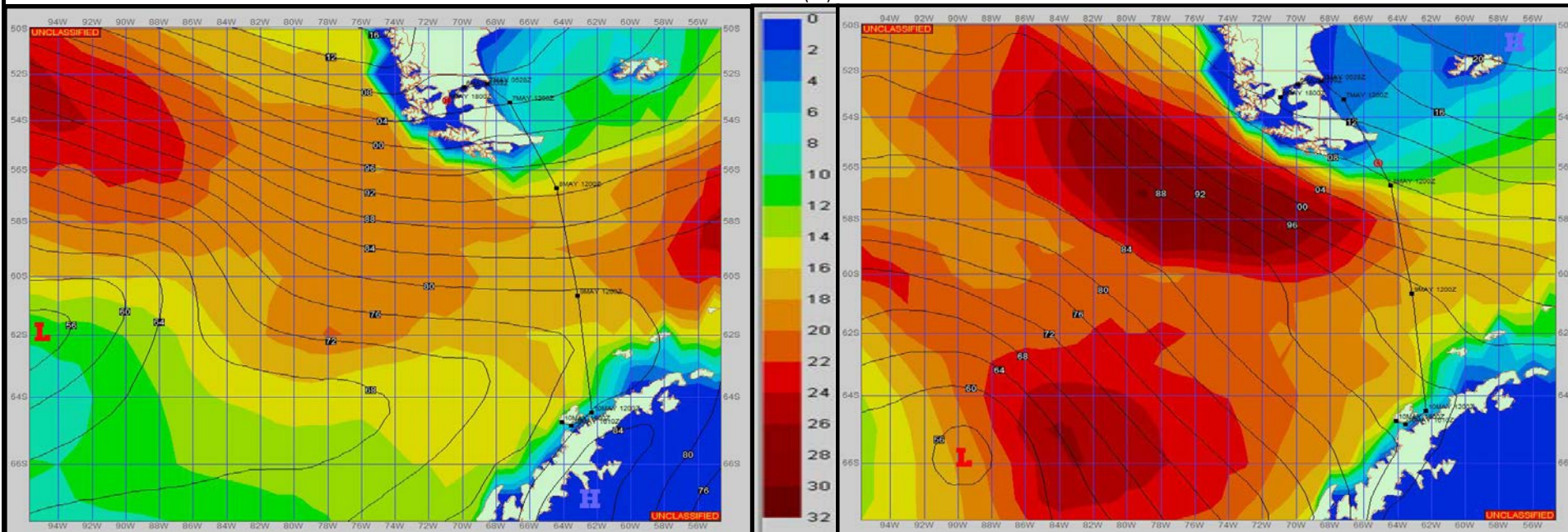

METSIT 21Z 6-May Pretty standard weather departing Punta Arenas for Palmer Station. The Straits of Magellan sees windy but calm seas while exiting the straits, the sea states do pick up a bit. Coming around the southern tip, late in the period, a deep low pressure system will be moving through the Drake Passage, with significantly increasing sea states. Safe travels south.
