

The high pressure ridging continues to create a strong off shore flow, though the winds look to slightly weaken over time. Outside of the winds, conditions look to be generally nice with some sun poking through the clouds and seas states continuing to be relatively calm. However, late in the period, as seen on the SFC Forecast chart, a deep low pressure system will be moving into the area from the southwest. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
