



**METSIT 00Z 9-Oct** AS THE STRONG LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM MOVES OFF TO THE EAST AND FINALLY EXITS THE DRAKE, A RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE WILL MOVE INTO THE AREA, BRINGING SOME FAIRER WEATHER. CLOUDS WILL LINGER AND SEA FOG WILL PREVAIL. AS YOU VENTURE FURTHER SOUTH, WINDS WILL CONTINUE TO BACK OFF. AS AIR TEMPERATURES BECOME NOTEABLY COLDER, THE ICING THREAT WILL REMAIN DESPITE THE LIGHTER WINDS. WAVE HEIGHTS WILL SLOWLY DIMINISH, THOUGH, ALONG WITH THE WINDS.
