

The low has moved out and while you head to the east side of Argentina/Chile, high pressure on the west side is entrenched the whole timeframe. The combination of the low moving out and exiting the Drake Passage, expect sea states to decrease pretty rapidly down to near calm as you head into the Strait of Magellan. However, a tight pressure gradient is in place, therefore expect strong gusty westerlies through the entire period.
