



METSIT 21Z 9-Jun The high pressure ridging continues with generally decent conditions. However, a deep low pressure system moves through the area increasing winds for ~12hrs near the middle of the forecast period before weakening as the low exits to the northeast. Sea states remain pretty calm, though a tighter gradient develops, so any westward movement could result in higher sea states pretty quickly. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
