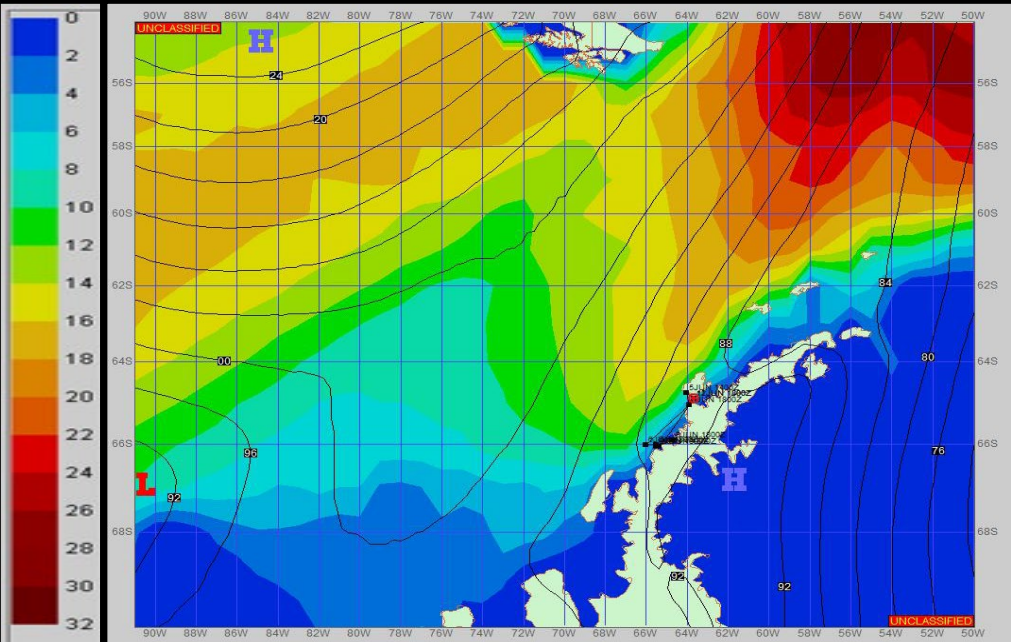
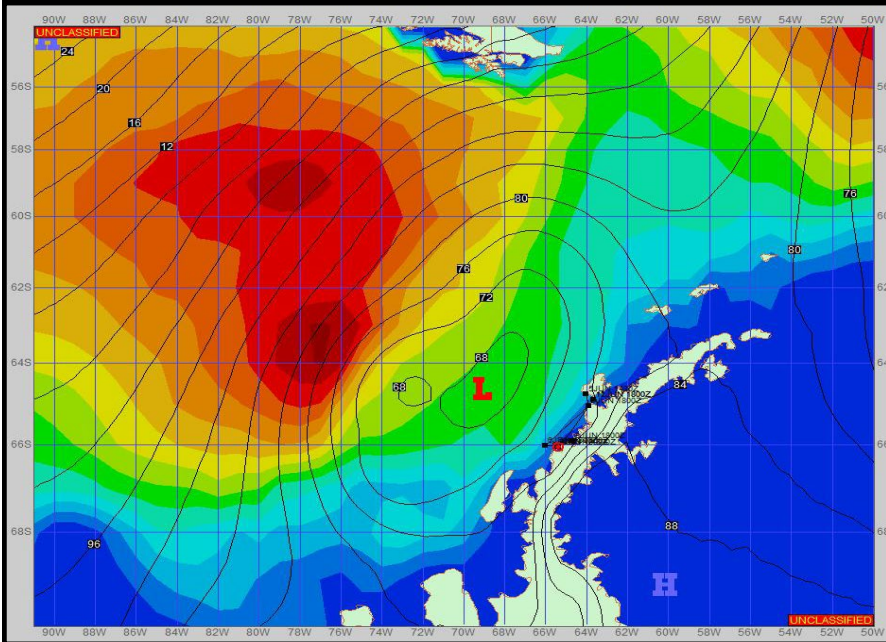


**SURFACE ANALYSIS 10-Jun-2023 18Z**

**METSIT 21Z 10-Jun** The high pressure ridging continues on the eastside of the peninsula. The storm, probably in the thick of it now, quickly moves northeast through the Drake. With it's clearing, expect clearer weather and lighter winds. However, the swell associated with the storm, is following behind. Sea states remain relatively calm closer to land, but with a tighter gradient, any westward movement could result in higher sea states pretty quickly. The next low pressure system is developing far out west and will eventually move into the area, beyond this forecast period though. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
