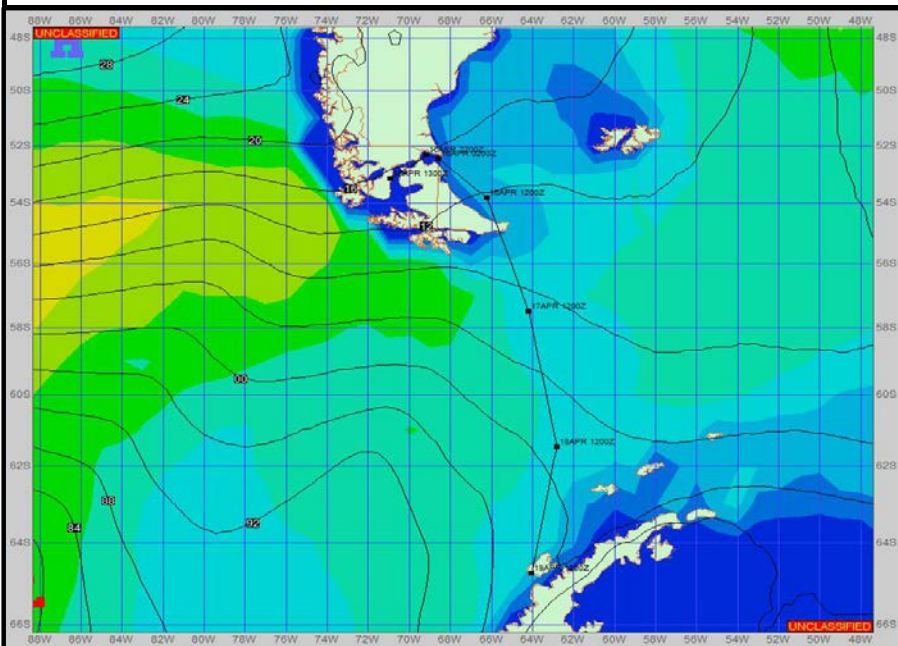


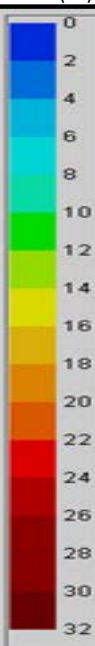

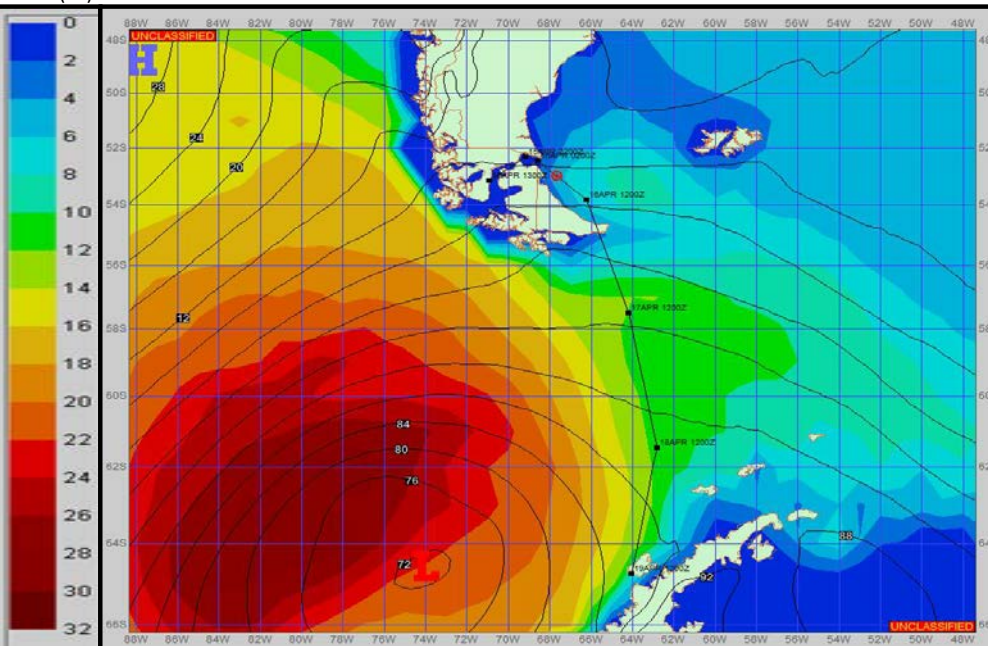
SURFACE ANALYSIS 14-Apr-2023 18Z

METSIT 21Z 14-Apr The last few hours in port will consist of some light rainshowers. Upon departure, winds will increase while transiting through the Straits of Magellan and out into Atlantic. Once in the open waters, sea states increase as well. Further in the forecast, a deepening low pressure system moves up from the Bellingshausen Sea along the peninsula and into the Drake Passage.
