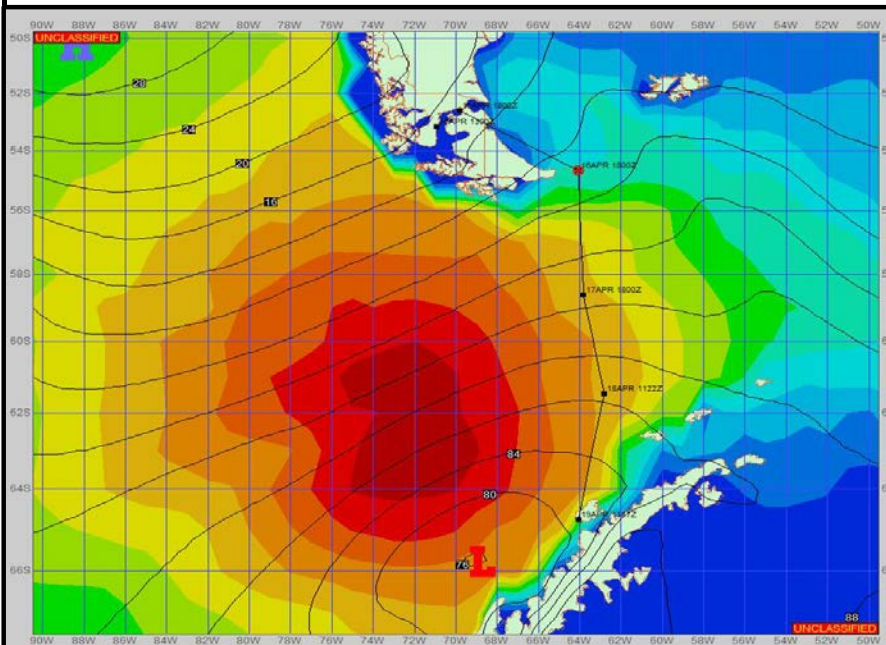

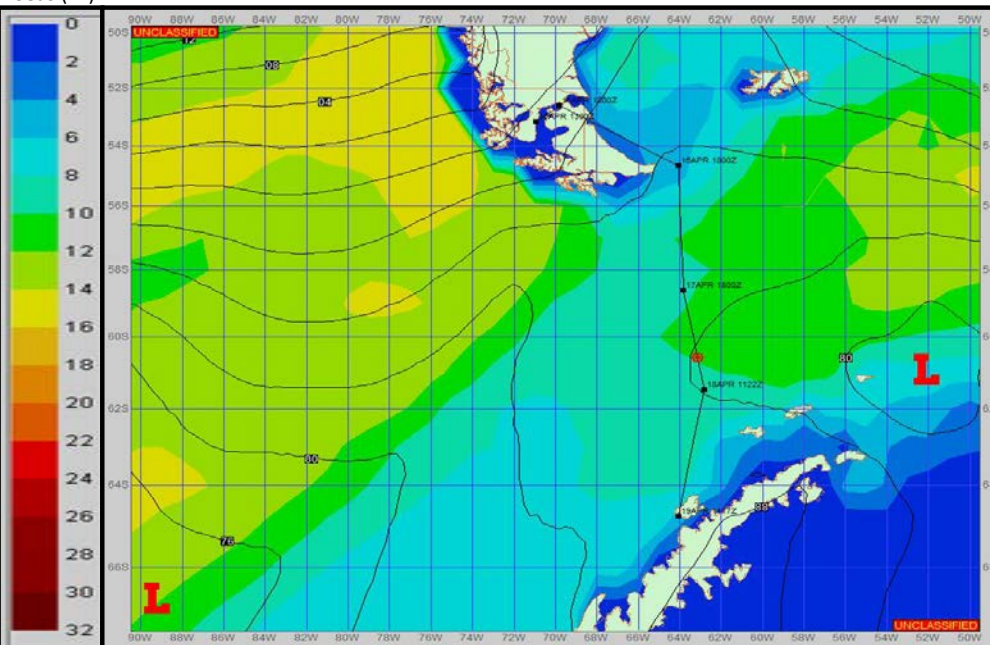

The low pressure riding up the peninsula weakens slightly as it continues moving northeast and eventually working it's way around the tip of the peninsula. You can still expect the strong winds while heading south and there will be enough energy to cause some high sea states early on. As that low weakens and also passes in front of you, winds decrease significantly and seas states will start coming down as well.
