

17-Mar
Safe travels heading north. No significant weather systems currently in the region. The next system will be approach west of the Drake Passage late in the period with a strong pressure gradient and increased sea states. By this point, you should be near the southern tip of Chile. Winds remain fairly steady and gusty from a westerly direction with increasing sea states until the start decreasing while approaching land. You can expect some occasional rain showers throughout the period.
