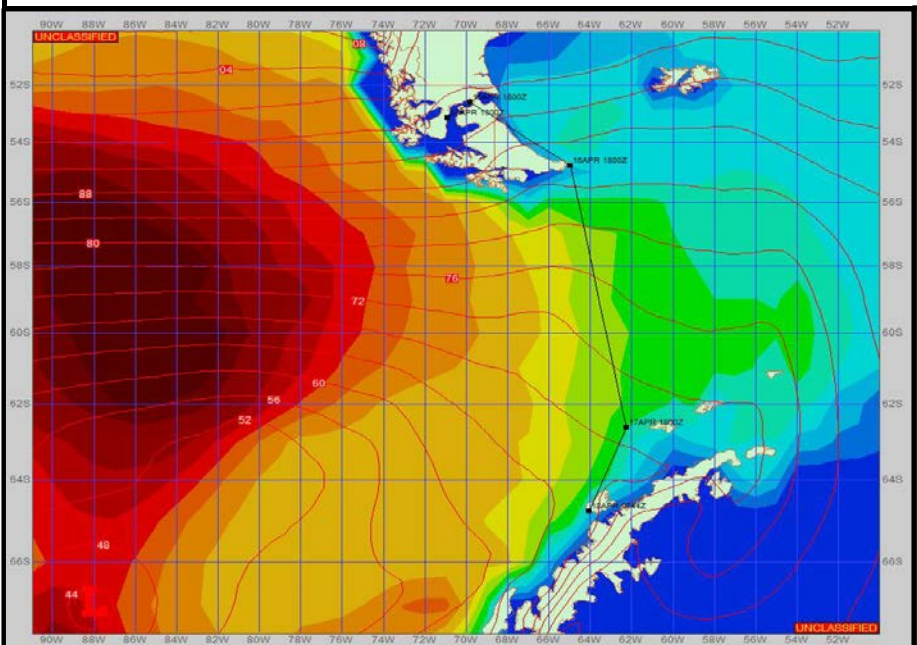
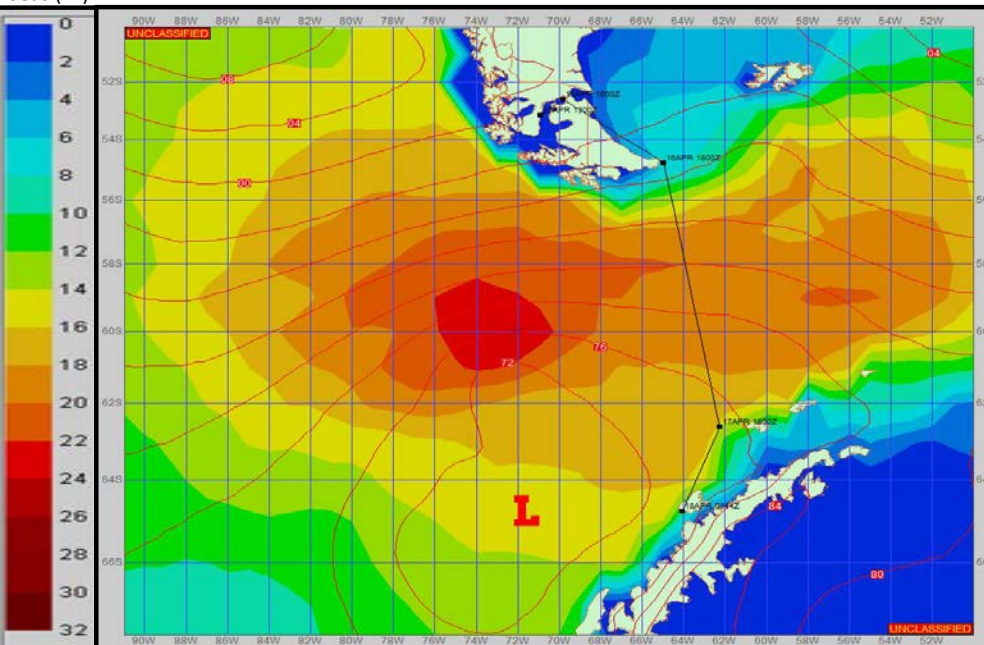

METSIT 21Z 19-Apr The low pressure in the Bellingshausen Sea continues to move northeast up the peninsula bringing strong winds with low visibility in snow and blowing snow. This is my final forecast unless otherwise required. Timely observations received from your ship are greatly appreciated. Outlook for arrival at your destination: Cloudy with 2-4, with periods of 1/2-2 in snow, blowing snow, freezing fog/mist. Winds NW-N 15-20 gusts to 25.
