

The low pressure system will continuing moving to the northeast and out of the area as high pressure starts nudging in. To start, expect strong winds, snow and **METSIT 21Z** 19-Jun low visibilities. As the low leaves and high moves in, this will bring in a lot less clouds and lighter winds. Seas states decrease as things calm down. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
