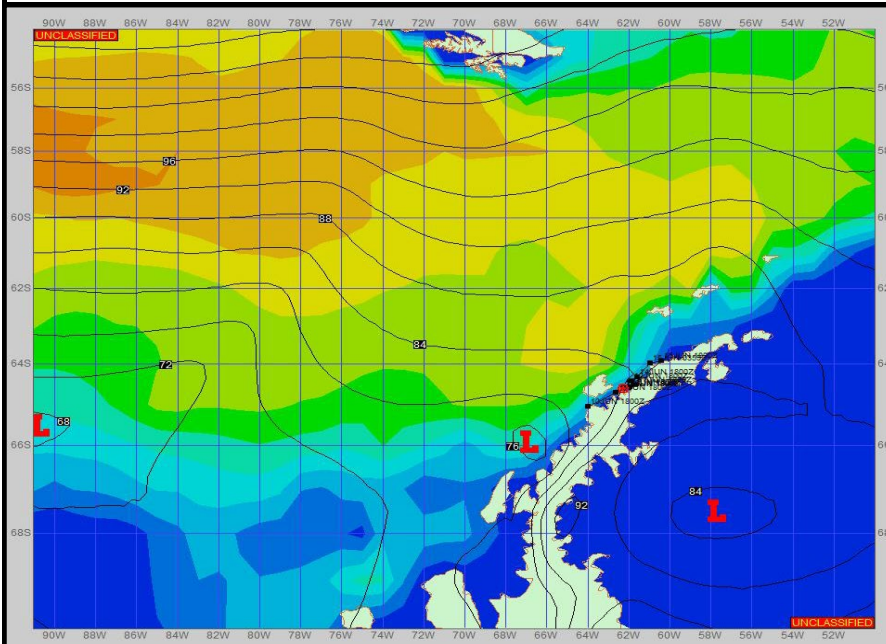
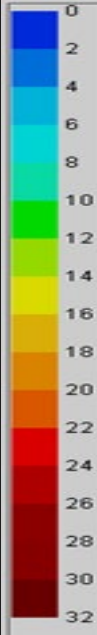


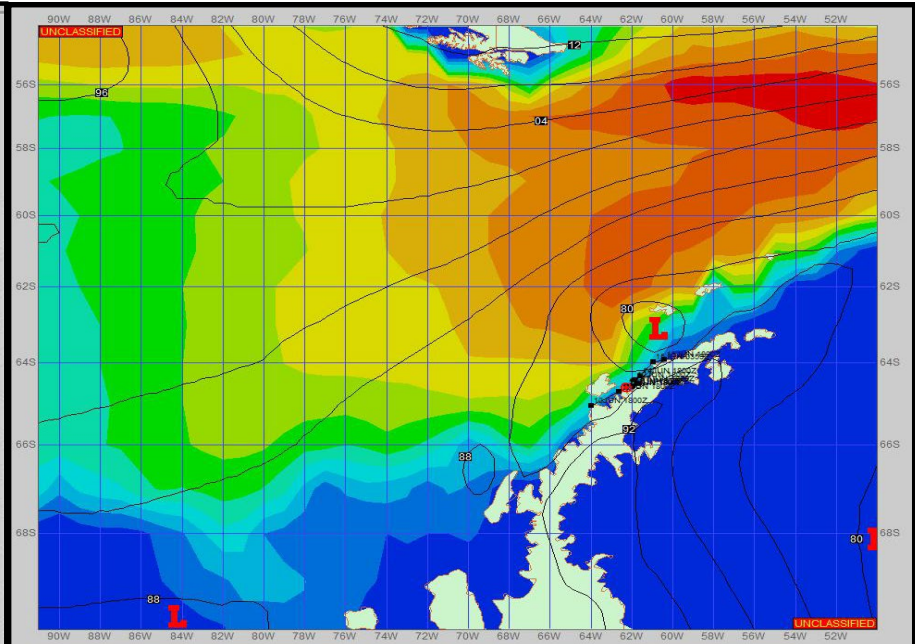
SURFACE ANALYSIS 19-Jun-2023 18Z

The low pressure system will continue moving to the northeast and out of the area as high pressure starts nudging in. To start, expect strong winds, snow and low visibilities. As the low leaves and high moves in, this will bring in a lot less clouds and lighter winds. Seas states decrease as things calm down. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
