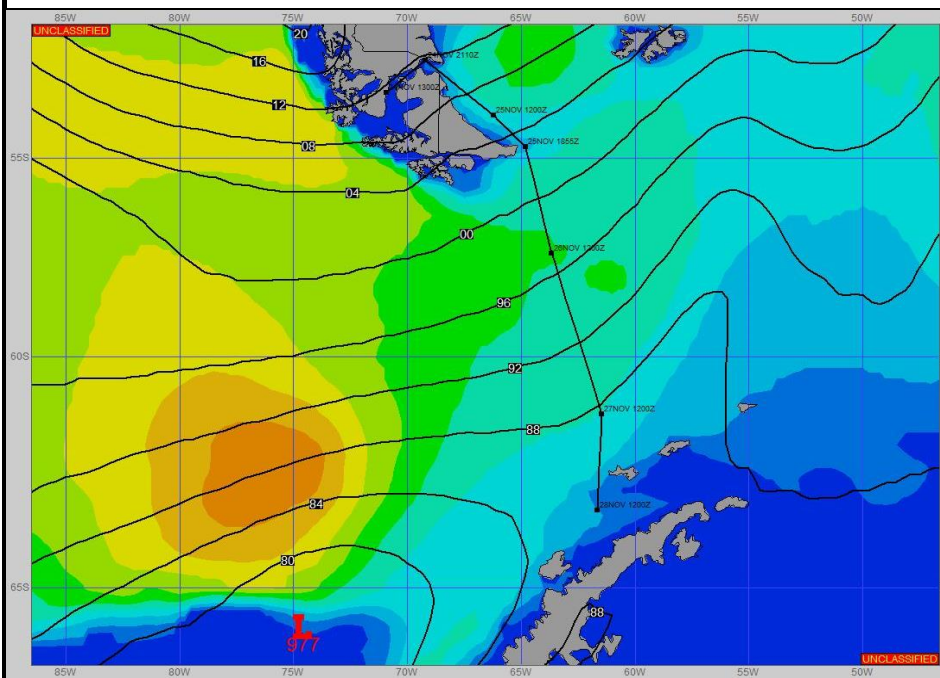


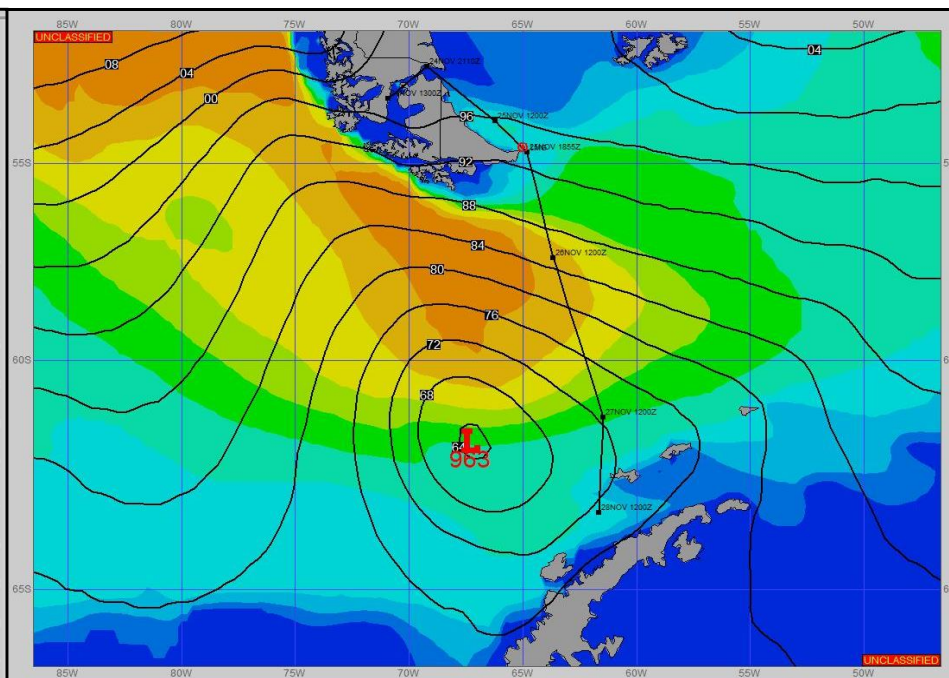

METSIT 06Z 24-Nov A LOW IN THE BELLINGSHAUSEN SEA DRAGS A WEAKENED FRONTAL BOUNDARY ACROSS THE SOUTHERN TIP OF SOUTH AMERICA, PRODUCING EXTENSIVE CLOUD COVER AND A FRESH BREEZE OVER YOUR PROJECTED ROUTE. THESE CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED THROUGH THE REMAINDER OF THE FORECAST PERIOD.
