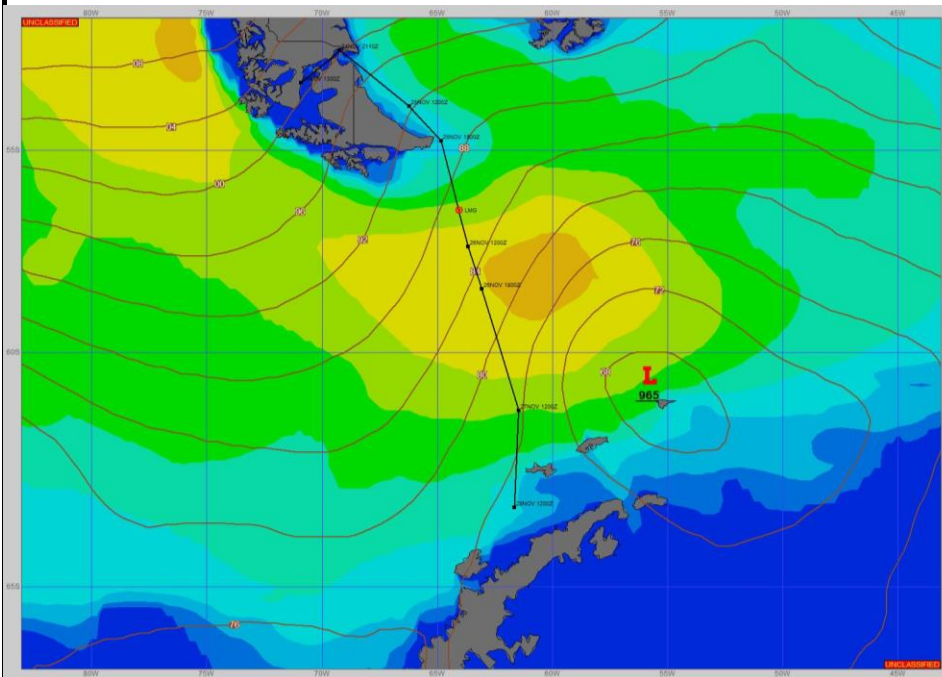


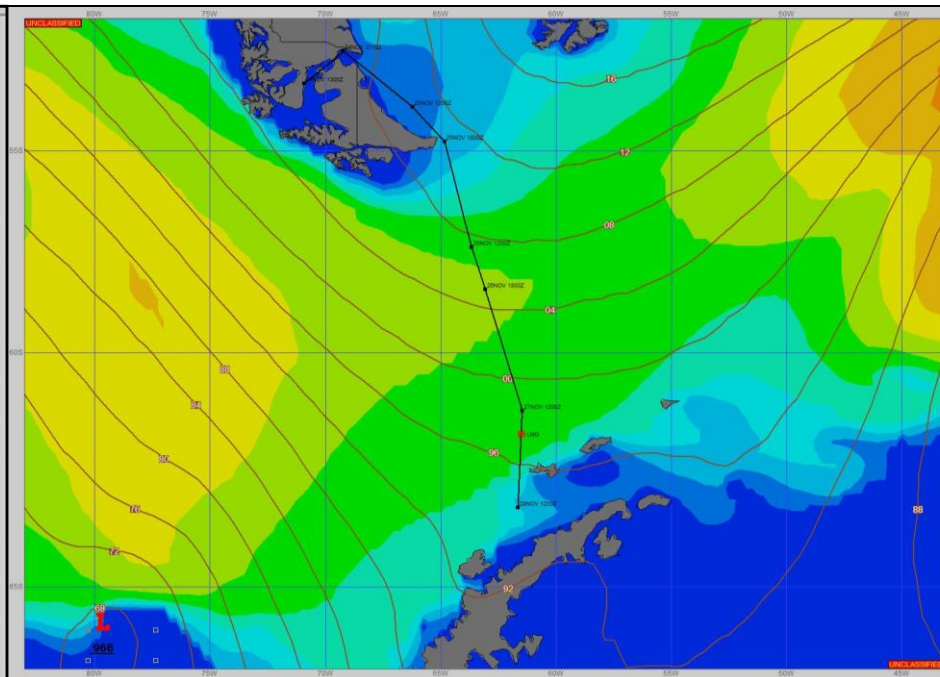

METSIT 06Z 26-Nov A LOW IS POSITIONED NEAR THE TIP OF THE ANTARCTIC PENINSULA AT 965MB CAUSING A TIGHTENED PRESSURE GRADIENT FOR THE DRAKE PASSAGE. STRONG WINDS AND INCREASED WAVE HEIGHTS ARE EXPECTED OVER THE NEXT 24 HOURS, WITH CONDITIONS GRADUALLY IMPROVING AS RIDGING MOVES OVER DRAKE PASSAGE, STEMMING FROM A HIGH THAT DEVELOPS NEAR THE FALKAN ISLANDS.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
