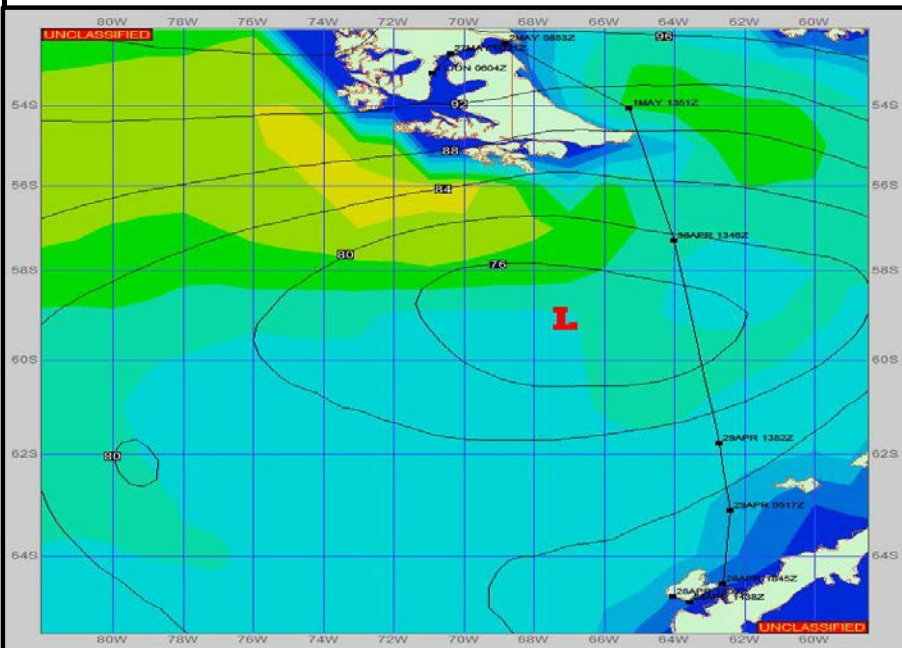


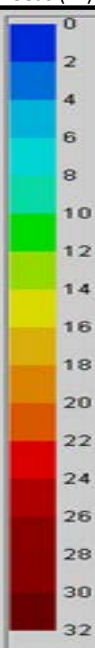

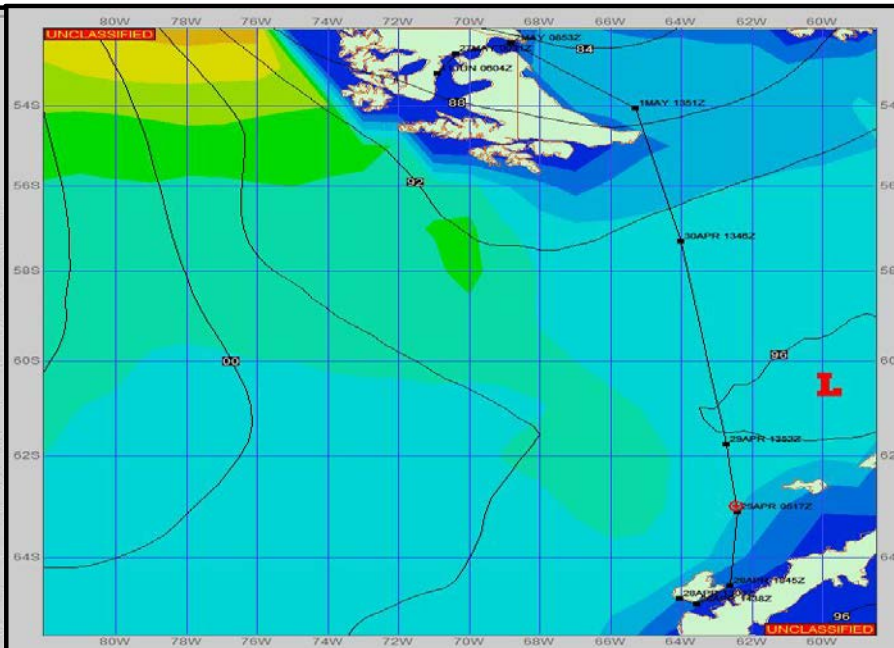
SURFACE ANALYSIS 27-Apr-2023 18Z

Generally pleasant conditions for the first part of the journey north. Still a little bit of snow at Palmer, but ending soon. As you head through the Gerlache Strait, the winds remain in the single digits to low teens. Coming out of the strait, the winds will pickup to the low to upper teens and out of a westerly direction. Sea states increase once in the open waters. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
