

**METSIT 21Z** 29-Mar The general west to east flow across the Drake continues with a low pressure moving down the pennisula later in the forecast period, after arriving to Palmer Station. Winds and sea states will still be moderate but will decrease as you get inland. Palmer Station expects to see increased winds and precipitation overnight and tomorrow.

Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
