

A tight pressure gradient between high pressure north, and a low pressure south keeps for strong gusty winds through the forecast period. Sea states will remain steady between 8-12 FT until you get into the Straits of Magellan. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
