



A series of low pressure systems push in from the west. Precipitation looks to be forecasted through much of the period. While it's cold enough for snow fall, it could occasionally be just warm enough for rain/snow mix, or even light rain. Reduced visibilities in heavier snow fall could occur. Winds will be generally to the south through the first part of the forecast with it switching to a westerly direction later in the period, with periods of strong gusty winds as those lows approach the area. Sea states pick up once outside of the sheltered areas. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands.
