



AS HIGH PRESSURE TO THE NORTH DRIFTS AWAY, A VERY WEAK LOW PRESSURE CENTER WILL FORM OVER THE ROSS SEA DUE TO THE HIGH'S ABSENCE. WHILE NOT PARTICULARLY VIGOROUS, THE LOW WILL PROVIDE JUST ENOUGH ENHANCEMENT FOR THE EXISTING CLOUD COVER AS WELL AS A RETURN TO LIGHT PRECIP AND FOG. WITH YOUR TRACK LOCATED MORE OR LESS IN THE CENTER OF THE WEAK LOW, THE WINDS WILL ALSO REMAIN ON THE LIGHTER SIDE.
