A LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM AT 990MB OVER DRAKE PASSAGE CONTINUES TO WEAKEN AND IS EXPECTED TO DIMINISH INTO A TROUGH BY 18Z. CLOUDY SKIES, PATCHY SEA FOG, AND LIGHT SHOWERY MIXED PRECIPITATION ARE EXPECTED IN THE VICINITY OF THE LOW CENTER MOVING TOWARDS THE SOUTH SHETLAND ISLANDS. FAIR WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED FOR THE PALMER ARCHIPELAGO IN THE AFTERNOON DUE TO HIGHER PRESSURE OVER THE REGION, HOWEVER CLOUDY SKIES AND PATCHY FOG MOVE OVER THE AREA SATURDAY EVENING.
