

OVERHEAD LOW PRESSURE WILL SLOWLY DEEPEND TODAY, INCREASING THE WINDS A BIT AND TRANSLATING TO SLIGHTLY HIGHER SEAS AS WELL. THE SOUTHERLY FLOW THAT DEVELOPS WILL BRING COOLER TEMPERATURES AND A POTENTIAL FOR FOG, THOUGH THAT THREAT WILL BE HAMPERED SOMEWHAT BY THE INCREASING CLOUD COVER. AS THE LOW MEANDERS EAST TOMORROW, WINDS WILL REMAIN GUSTY BUT OVERALL CONDITIONS AREN'T EXPECTED TO WORSEN FURTHER AS THE LOW DRIFTS AWAY.
