

The low pressure to the west, has little movement to it and also fills over most of the forecast period. The next low forms late in the period and will track to the northeast of the science area. The result of all this will bring in sporadic light drizzle/showers or possible light flurries depending on the temperature at the time. Winds continue to be generally light and variable with it increasing at the end of the period. Sea states will be light nearer the land and a bit higher as you move away and into more open waters.
