

5-Apr The next low forms late in the period and will track to the northeast and north of the science area. Winds continue to be generally light and variable with a slight increase during the middle part of the forecast period before decreasing. Much of this is due to the distance from shore and into open waters. Sea states will be light nearer the land and a bit higher as you move away and into more open waters.
