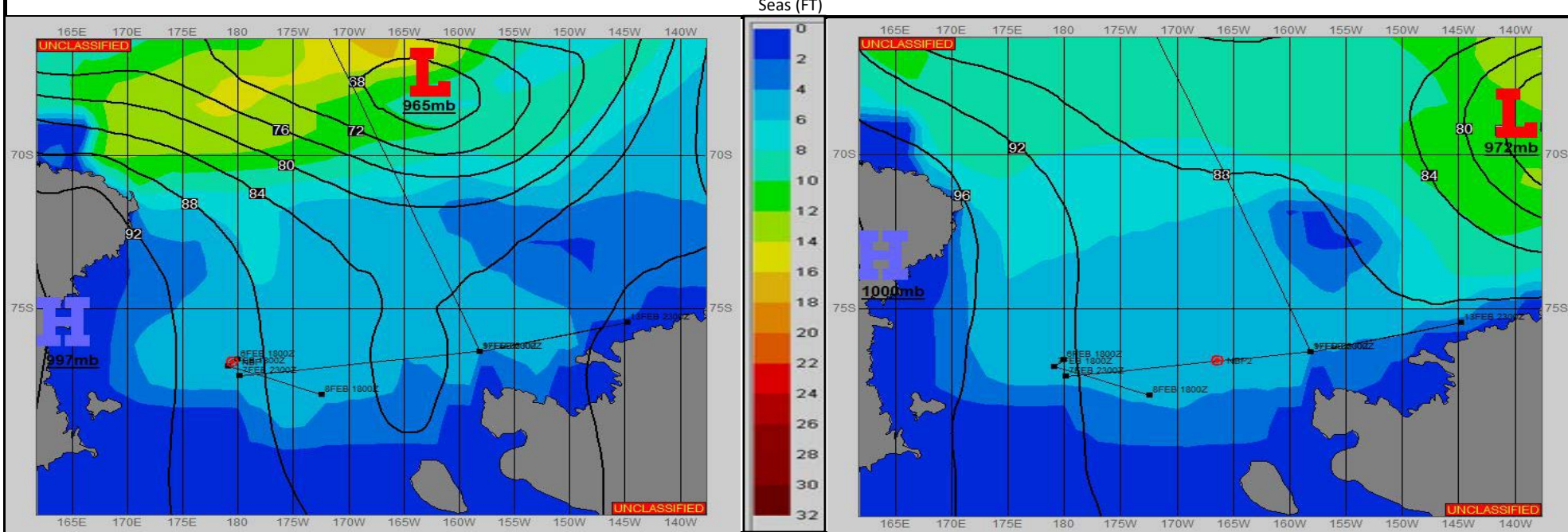

METSIT 06Z 7-Feb THE SOUTHERLY OUTFLOW FROM THE ROSS ICE SHELF CONTINUES TO BE THE DEFINING FEATURE OF TODAY'S FORECAST. CLOUDS WILL BE IN AND OUT ONCE AGAIN, WITH ANOTHER ROUND OF COOLER TEMPERATURES. HOWEVER, WITH YOUR EASTWARD TREK, TOMORROW WILL SEE YOU LEAVE THE EXHAUST PIPE OF SOUTHERLY WINDS, AND A SLIGHT REVERSAL WILL TAKE PLACE. WEAKER WINDS FROM THE NORTH WILL TAKE OVER, SHIFTING THE SWELL DIRECTION ACCORDINGLY, AND BRINGING IN SOME MILDLY WARMER TEMPERATURES.
