

The low pressure system should be moving just north of the science area and will begin to fill just east of your tracked location. Just then, the next low will be moving into the area, north of your location and will track east southeast. You should experience strong gusty winds as the current low center is just north. Being on the bottom side of the low, winds will be southerly and rotate around to westerly, while also decreasing in speed as that low fills. Precipitation is expected with the current system, with heavier precipitation occurring north before ending as the low moves east.
