

THE SOUTHERLY OFF-CONTINENT BREEZE WILL EVENTUALLY SWITCH TOMORROW TO A NORTHERLY BREEZE, AS HIGH PRESSURE BUILDS IN SLIGHTLY FROM THE NORTH AS WELL. CLOUDS WILL CONTINUE TO BE IN AND OUT, BUT OVERALL CONDITIONS WILL BE FAIRLY MILD THROUGH THE PERIOD.
