

The weather making low pressure system has now moved to the east of New Zealand. High pressure builds in over the South Island bringing some clearing skies before clouds move back in later. Winds do pick up later in the forcast period with a tight pressure gradient between the high and another low pressure system that will once again transit from west to east in the southern ocean.
