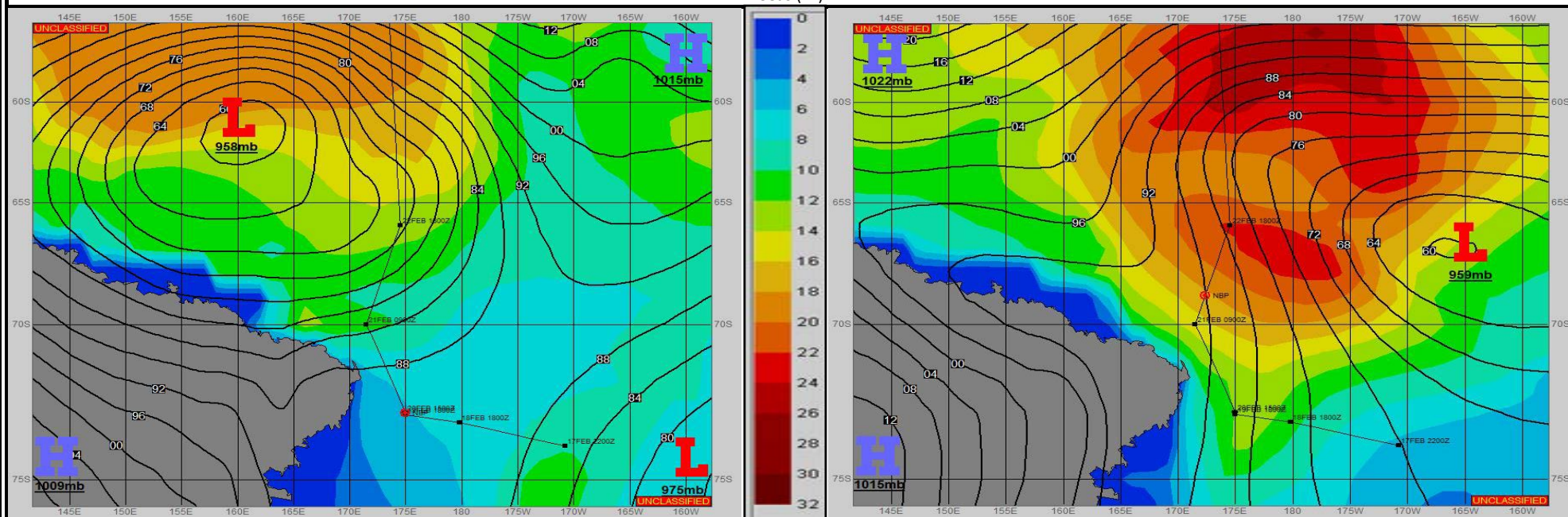


SURFACE ANALYSIS 20-Feb-2023 06Z

METSIT 06Z 20-Feb STRONG LOW PRESSURE WILL DROP SOUTHEAST TODAY AND SKIRT BY CAPE ADARE. AS THE SPHERE OF INFLUENCE OF THE LOW APPROACHES, A MODERATE WIND WILL QUICKLY PICK UP ALONG WITH SIG WAVE HEIGHTS. CLOUDINESS AND MIXED PRECIPITATION WILL ALSO COMMENCE LATER TONIGHT AND MORESO INTO TOMORROW. WIND SPEEDS WILL GENERALLY LAST THROUGH TOMORROW, BUT THE DIRECTION WILL SHIFT TO MORE SOUTHERLY AS THE LOW HEADS EASTWARD AND AWAY. EXPECT SEA STATES TO REMAIN ON THE HIGHER SIDE THROUGH THE FORECAST PERIOD AS WELL.
