

20-Mar
Strong gusty winds continue with periods of rain through the rest of the day. While you loiter north of Banks Peninsula, you can expect to feel the affects from the low southeast of the southern island, to include strong gusty winds and slightly higher sea states, though not as bad if you would've departed as scheduled. As the low starts to fill, conditions will improve. Clouds start to clear and the rain ends. Winds will weaken a bit, but sea states will remain slightly high.
