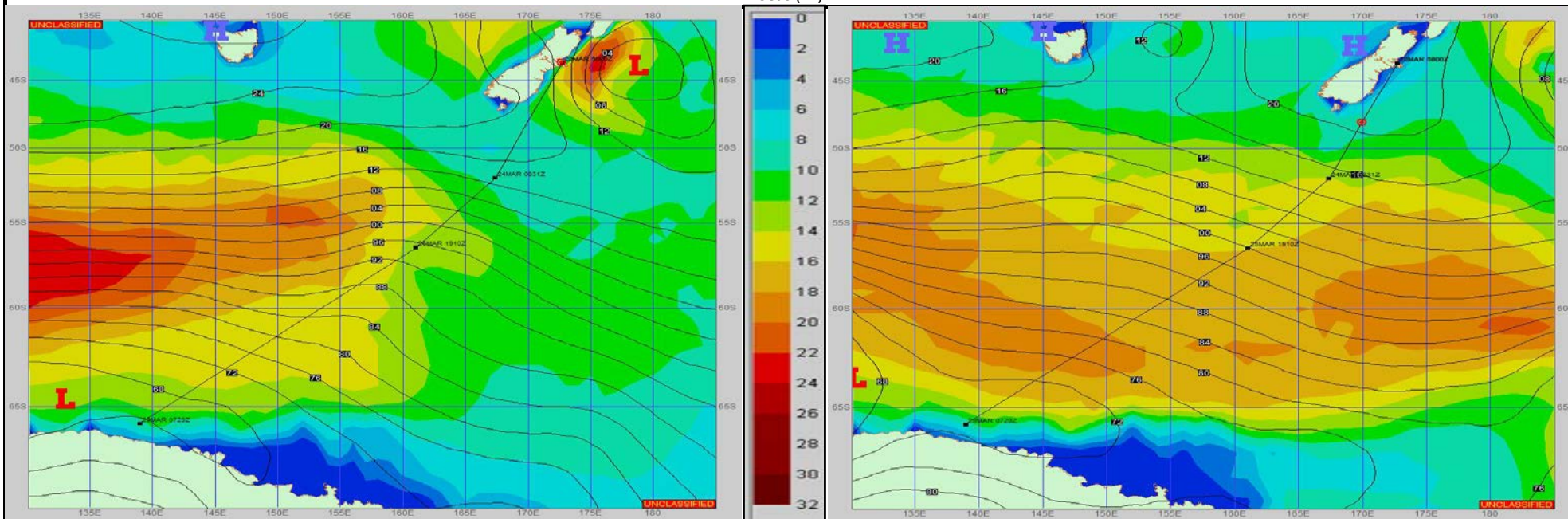

METSIT 21Z 21-Mar The low pressure from the previous days finally exits out of the area, moving east. High pressure builds in, over the islands the next few days. The strong gusty southwesterly winds will decrease as the low moves out and as you also move away. Winds pickup at the end of the forecast period as you start moving out from behind sheltered waters and into the open waters. Sea states will pick up out in the open waters as well. Safe travels as you progress south over the next week and back into Antarctic waters.
