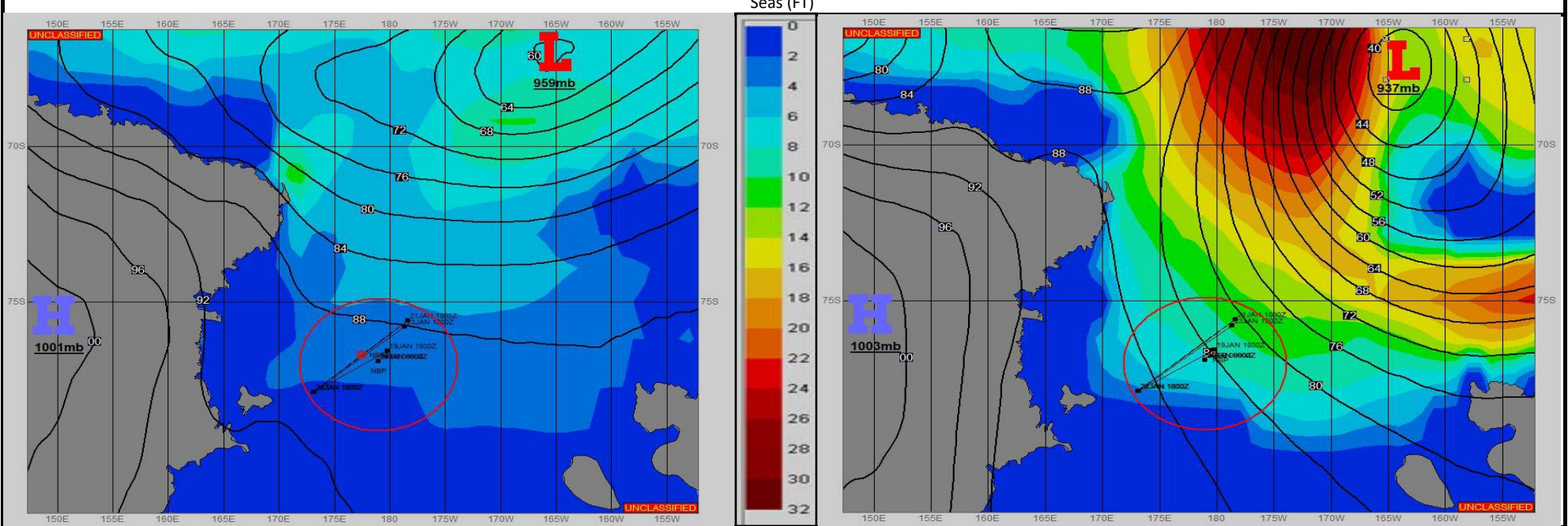

METSIT 06Z 22-Jan A STATIONARY LOW PRESSURE CENTER IN THE NORTHERN ROSS SEA WILL STRENGTHEN OVER THE NEXT FEW DAYS AS AN INCOMING RIDGE FROM THE NORTHWEST ENHANCES THE LOW. CLOUD COVER, WIND, AND WAVE HEIGHTS CAN ALL BE EXPECTED TO INCREASE THROUGH THE FORECAST PERIOD, AS THE LOW DEEPENS. PERIODS OF SNOW AND FOG WILL ALSO INCREASE WITH THE AVAILABLE MOISTURE. OVERALL, CONDITIONS FURTHER NORTHEAST WITHIN YOUR MODLOC AREA WILL BE WORSE THAN CONDITIONS IN THE SOUTHWEST SECTOR.
