


Ref B: Situation Report for 22 June 2023 Ref A: 18JUN23 MOVREP



METSIT 21Z A low moves west to east in the Drake. High pressure builds in with pretty stable conditions through most of the forecast period. A short period of light 22-Jun snow may develop with some slight visibility reductions while in port. A low begins to approach low at the end of the period. Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands. This is my final forecast unless otherwise required. Timely observations received from your ship are greatly appreciated. Next forecast will be provided upon receipt of new MOVREP.
