

A deepening low pressure system drifts in from the northwest and will basically stall. A tight pressure gradient exists between that low and a continental high pressure through the entire forecast period. Expect the winds to switch directions multiple times, around the entire compass rose throughout. Sea states will remain fairly calm, but do pickup up further out from the continent. A period of snow pass through as a trough moves through the area which will reduce visibilities, especially in heavier snow bands.
