

26-Apr Interesting setup occurring. The low pressure early in the forecast, northwest of Davis Station is essentially stationary. It eventually drifts to the northeast and begins to weaken. All the while this is happening, another low rotates on the north side of the that low and moves to the northeast of the first low, while moving to the east. What all that adds up to is a pressure gradient that keeps gusty winds. Sea states will be low, until you head north. Getting away from the continent and into the open waters, those low pressure systems kick up the seas.
