

26-Mar Continuing with the track on the north side of the low as the high pressure moves in, expect exactly the reason for the path taken. Winds continue westerly before switching to a southerly direction to an easterly direction and finally from the north as you move through the high pressure. Slightly stronger winds moving through the edge of the high and fairly light winds while in the center of the high before picking back up on the back edge of the high. Sea states continue to be from the southwest and will slowly decline as you progress. All temperatures will decline, and decline pretty rapidly as you continue moving south.
