

METSIT 21Z The low pressure to the northeast continues moving northeast trails a deep trough stretches all the way down southwest of your location incorporating 27-Apr the low northwest identified on the sfc analysis. A new, and deepening low enters from the west late in the period. Winds switch from easterly to westerly around 28/04z. Following the switch, winds remain southerly and gusty through most of the rest of the period. Sea states remain low until the end where they start picking up, moving into the open ocean.
